2.	Downtown Improvements – Electric Vehicle Charging Stations at 104 E. Main Street The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) has been awarded a \$15 million grant from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to support the installation of electric vehicle (EV) charging stations on public property throughout the region. The goal is to add up to 100 new charging ports, with a focus on addressing service gaps and promoting equitable access across North Central Texas.
	The Quinlan Economic Development Corporation (QEDC) would like to apply for this grant to install two Level II EV charging stations at the Quinlan Police Station, located at 104 E. Main Street. Engineering for this location has been completed by Kimley-Horn, and the site is now ready for submission of the grant application to NCTCOG.
	Council is requested to review and consider approval of the proposed installation. Adding EV charging infrastructure in Downtown Quinlan is expected to increase foot traffic and attract visitors who may not otherwise travel beyond their own communities, thereby supporting local businesses and economic growth in the downtown area.
